

Colorado Clays Trap League – Scoring

Scoring will be by the three-point method.

First Point: The first point is awarded to the team with the highest combined singles score plus their calculated handicaps.

- **Step 1:** Determine your personal handicap calculation percentage: If your singles average is greater than or equal to 18 your percentage is 70% and if it is 17.9 or less your percentage is 80%.
- **Step 2:** Calculate your personal handicap (HCP): The formula is 24 minus your singles average multiplied by your personal handicap percentage. 24 is the maximum value you can get with this calculation.

For example, if your average is a 20 then your personal handicap calculation is:

$$(24 - 20) * .7 = 2.8$$

- **Step 3:** Add your personal handicap calculation (HCP) to your singles score to get your combined score. Add all shooters combined scores to get team combined score.

Second Point: The second point is awarded to the highest team score for the yardage round. Add up the raw scores of all the shooters of their second round which is shot at a handicap yardage based on team standing in their division.

Third Point: The third point is awarded to the team with highest total of both rounds. Ties will receive 1/2 point. For example, the combined singles score of 119.2 added to the yardage score of 99 equals a grand total of 218.2.
